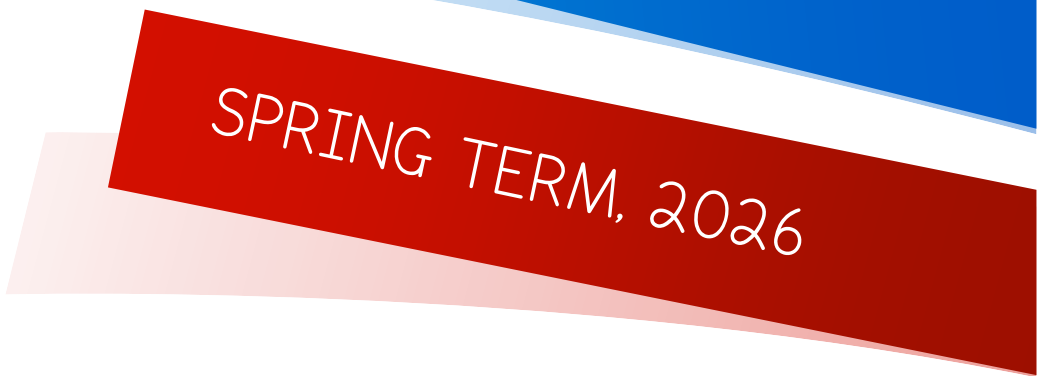
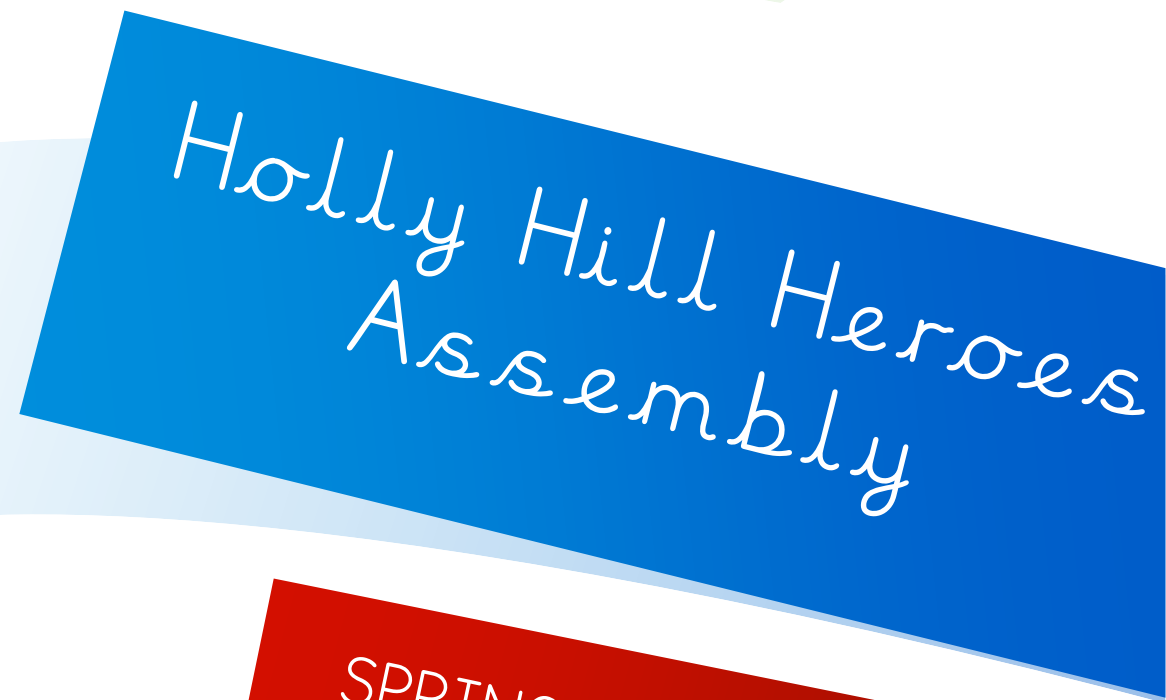
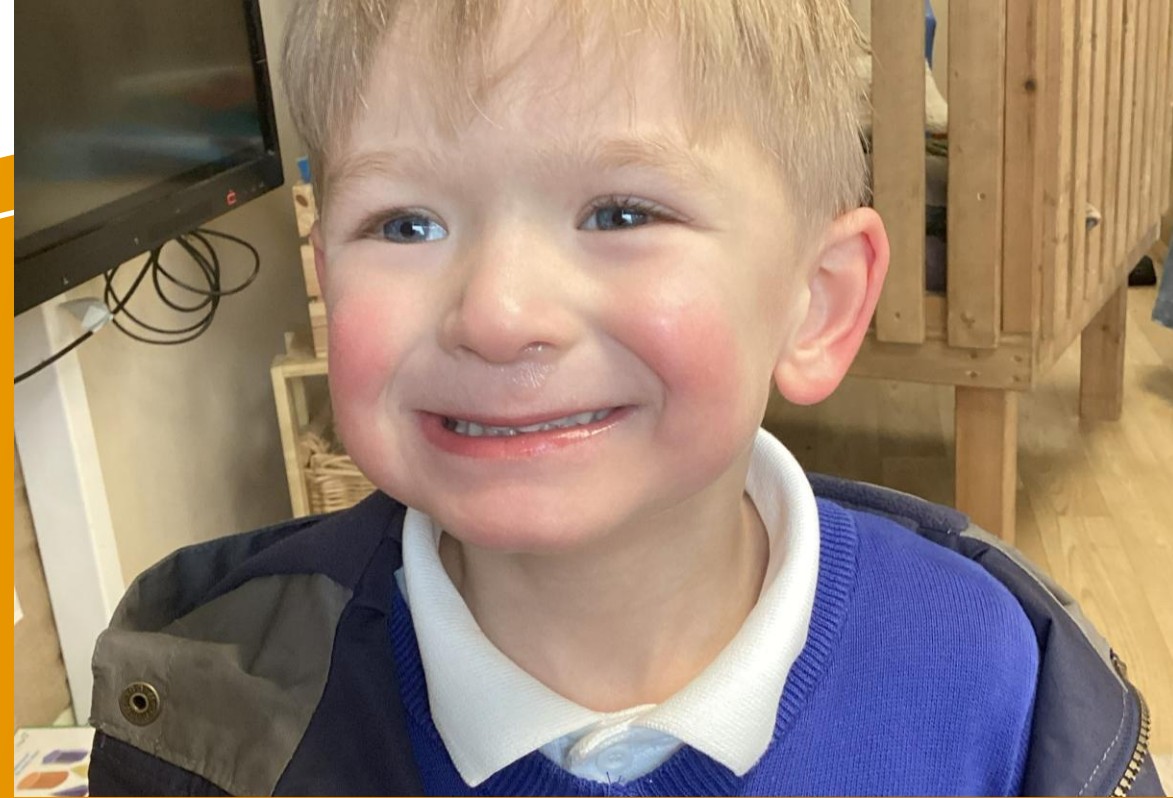




Our Cygnets Hero

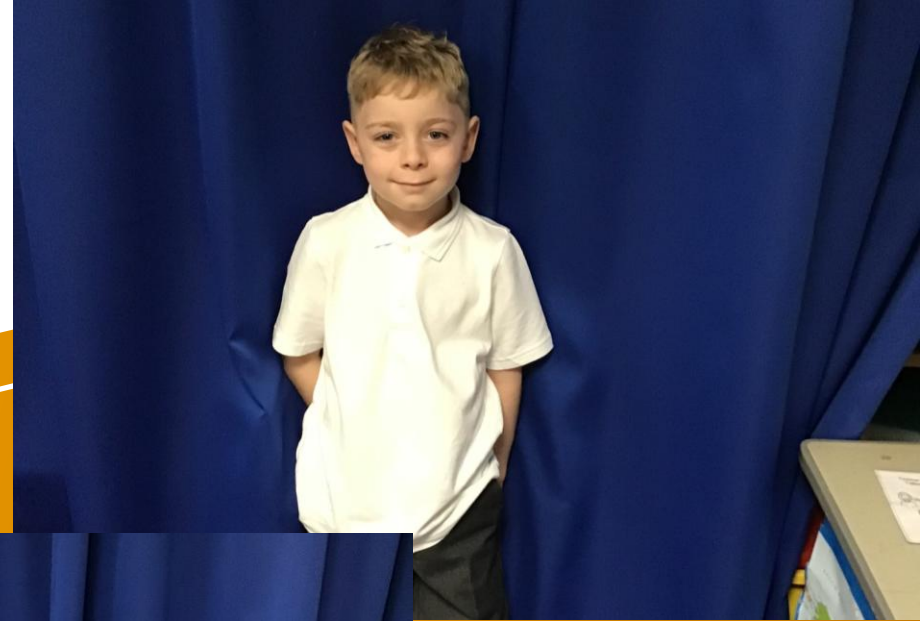


Our Woodpecker Heroes

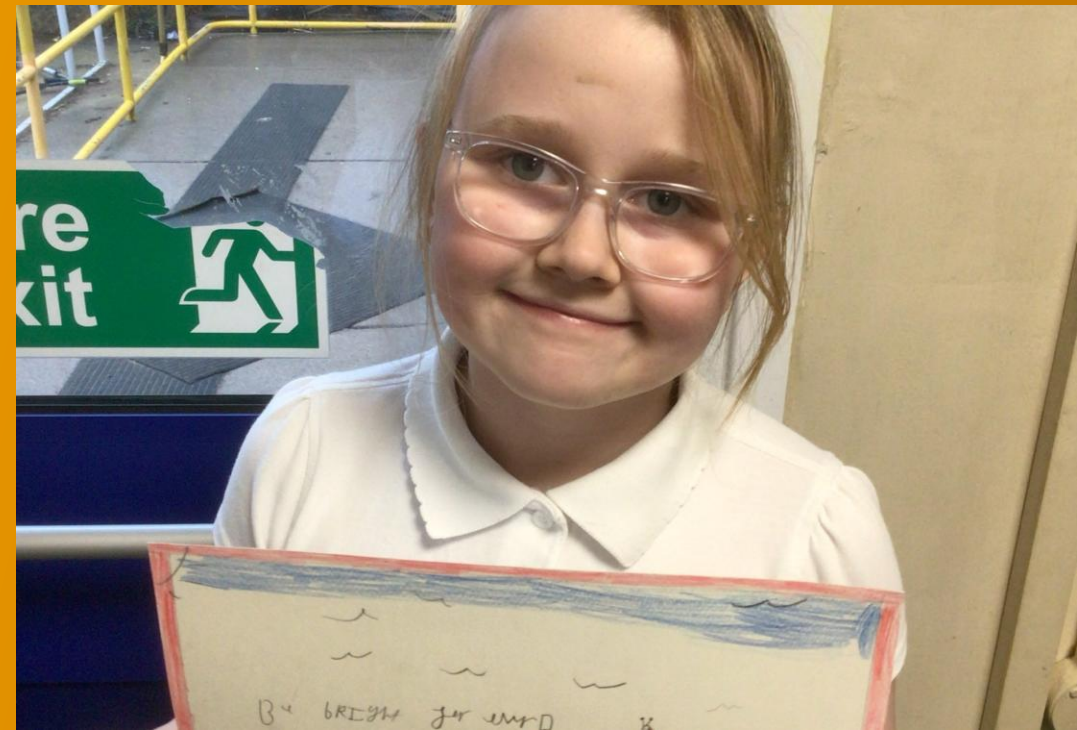
Our Swallow Hero

Our Falcon Heroes

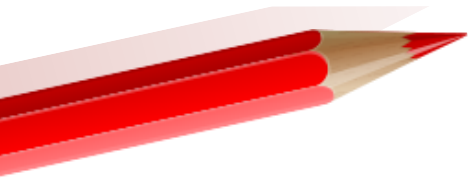

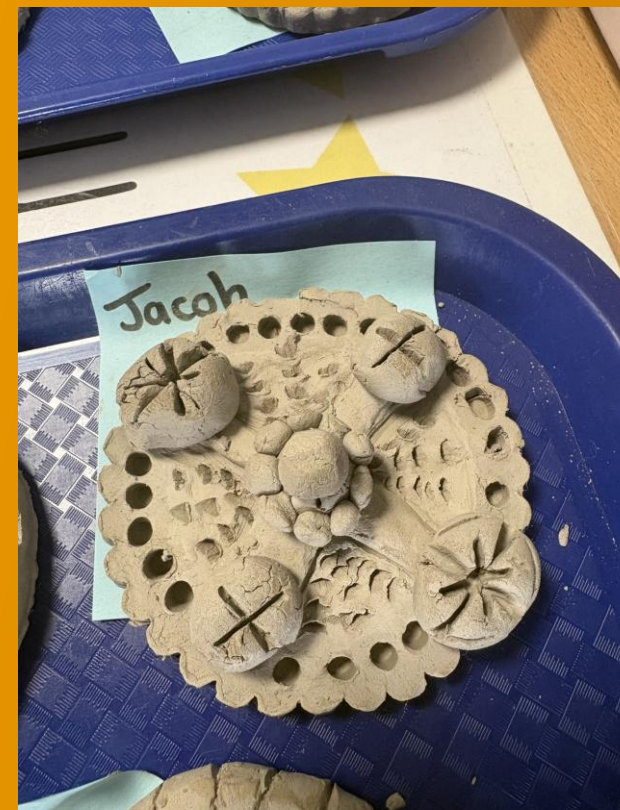


Our Swan Heroes
