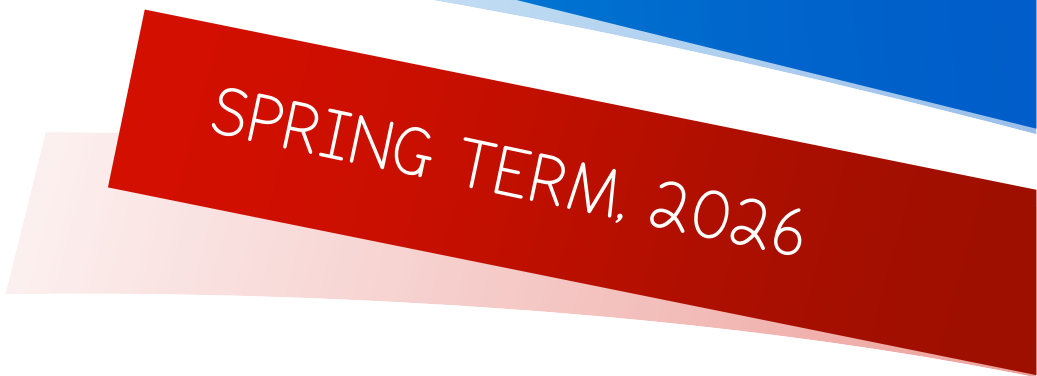
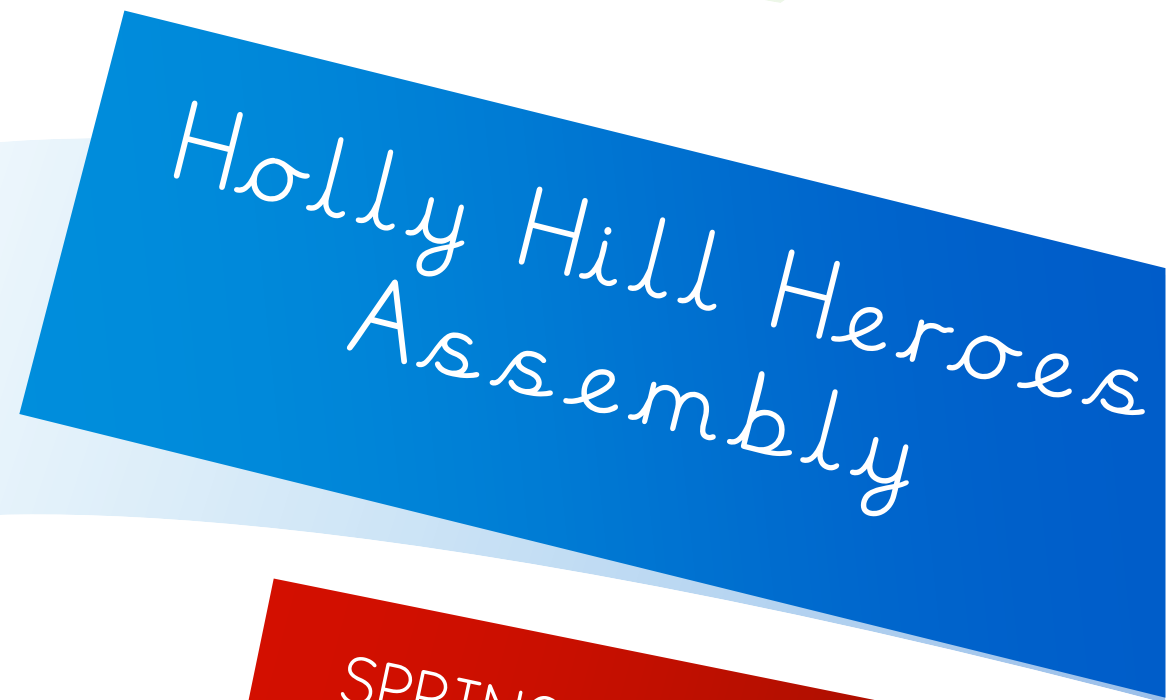




Our Cygnets 1

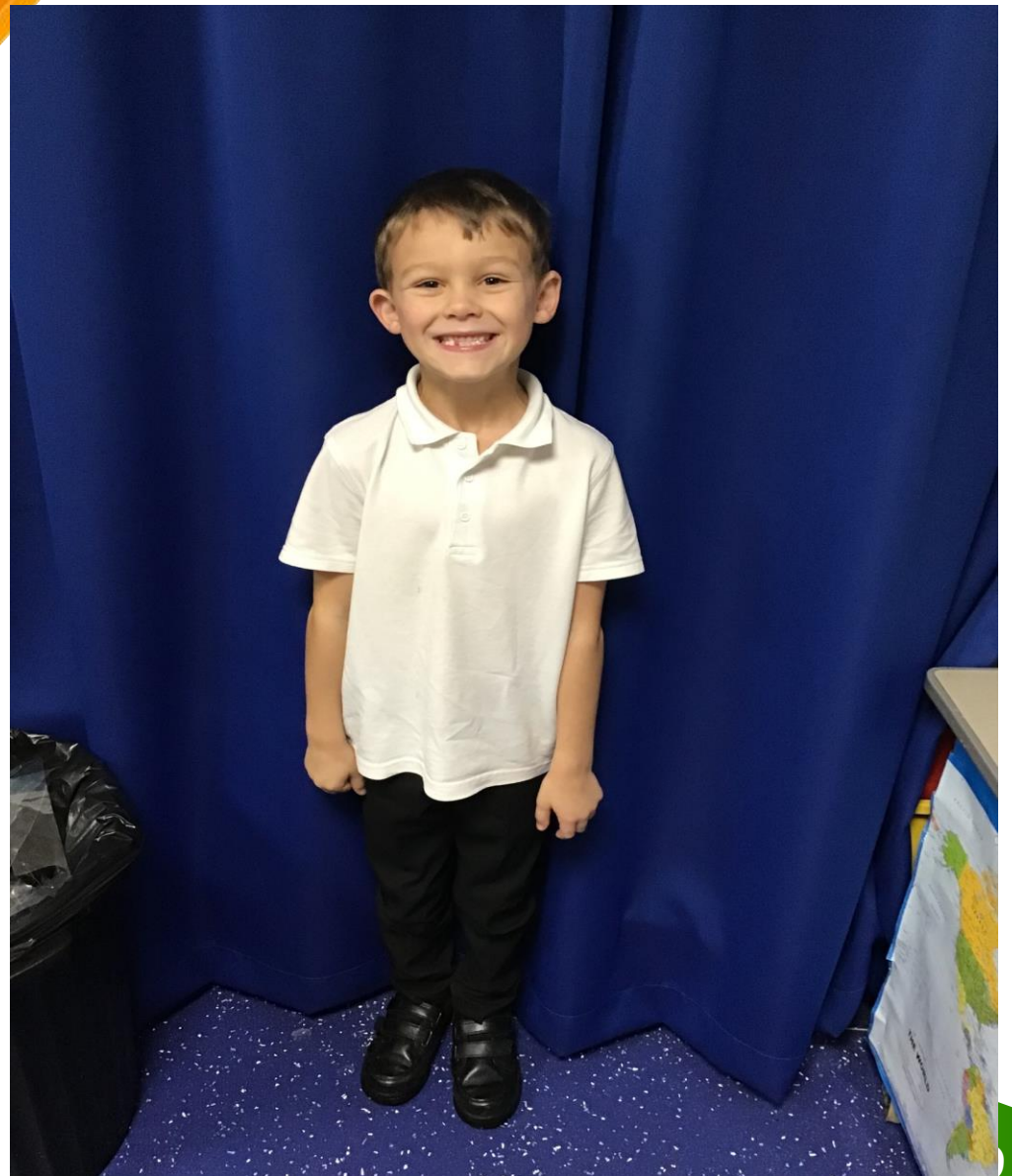
Our Wren Hero -Oscar

Our Woodpecker Hero - Kolby

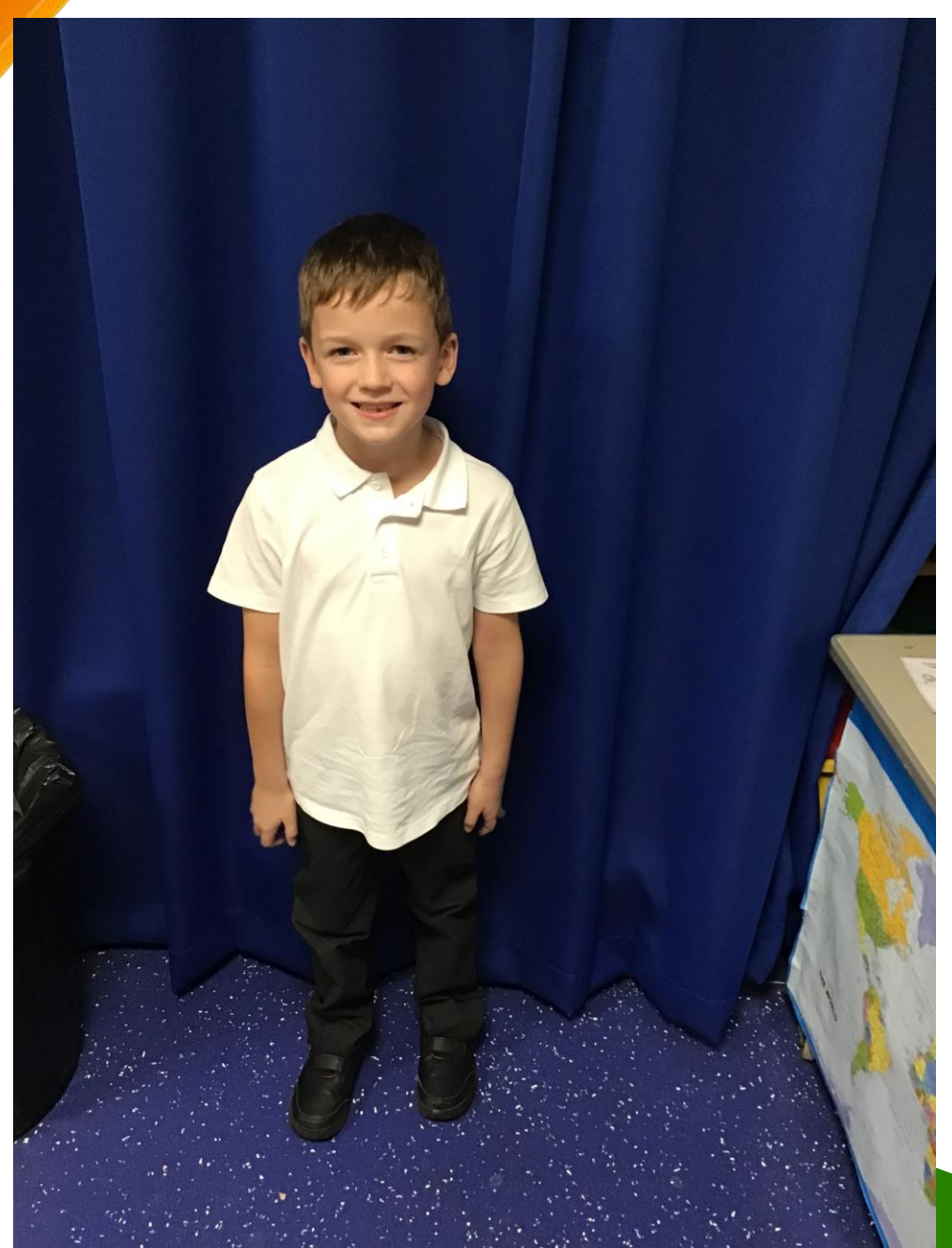

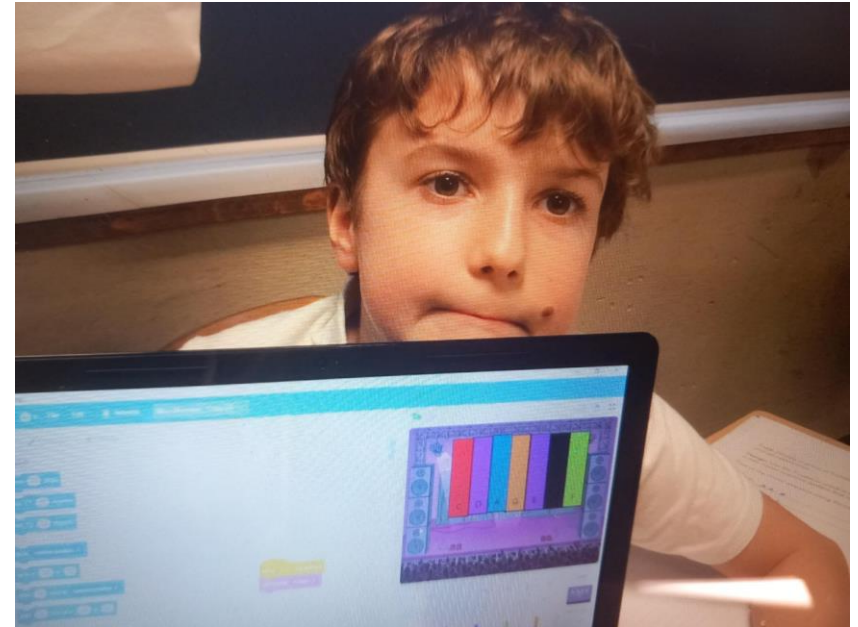
Our Dove Hero
