Observational drawing – a drawing what you see in front of you as real and as true to life as possible.

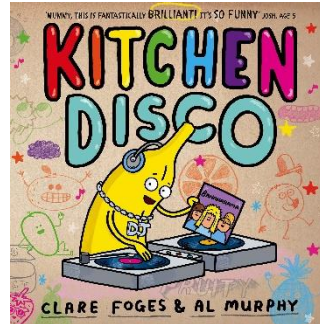
Word Reading and Comprehension
