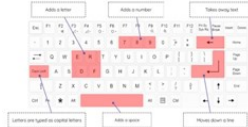
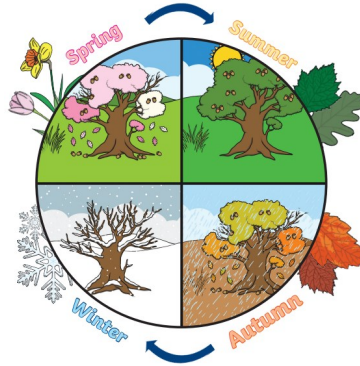

- There are 3 primary colours - red, blue and yellow. - The primary colours can be mixed together to form secondary colours - orange, green and purple. - Tint of colours can be made by adding white. - Tones of colours can be made by adding black. - Brushes of different thicknesses can be used in painting to create different effects. - Artists such as Kandinsky, Mondrian, Pollock, Klee and Robert Delauney use colour in their paintings using different techniques. - Colour can be used to create moods and feelings in paintings e.g. hot and cold colours.	- Icons on tool bars / tabs are similar between programs used to create digital painting or writing.  - The keyboard, / tool bar icons change the way the text or images looks.  - Formatting text can include changing the way text looks eg bold, underline, font size or style. - Text can be selected through double clicking or click and drag. - A continuous freehand line is needed when drawing shapes that need to be filled in using the fill tool. - Privacy and security includes 'what personal information to share.' - Copyright and ownership includes that 'work I create belongs to me' or 'other people will know who the work belongs to when I name it.'	- There are many environmental changes across the 4 seasons. - The four seasons are Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn. - Different weathers are associated with the seasons and the day length varies.  (Summer/ Autumn focus)	COMPUTING Erase - to remove or delete data Fill - changing part of an image to a colour or pattern Undo - removes the last change made to the document, image or file Redo - reverses the last change made by undo Text - words, letters or numbers Select - to choose or highlight text or objects SCIENCE Autumn - the season after summer and before winter. A time where leaves change and fall from trees. Winter - the season after autumn and before spring and the coldest season of the year. Spring-the season when cold temperatures gradually rise. Summer - the warmest month of the year. Seasons - four parts of the year where weather changes.
