Reading



Your child has been given a story book. We call this a 'reading for pleasure' book. This book is for parents to read and share with your child at home. We don't expect your child to be able to read this!

Please record every time you share this book with your child. You can write a comment in your child's reading diary (F2s) or simply write your initials on your child's reading record chart. (F1s)

We will change this book every Thursday so please make sure it comes to school so that your child can swap it. We will also count how many times your child has read and put their name on our reading chart. Children can choose a prize from our prize box if they read 4 times or more!
