Reading breakfasts – thank you

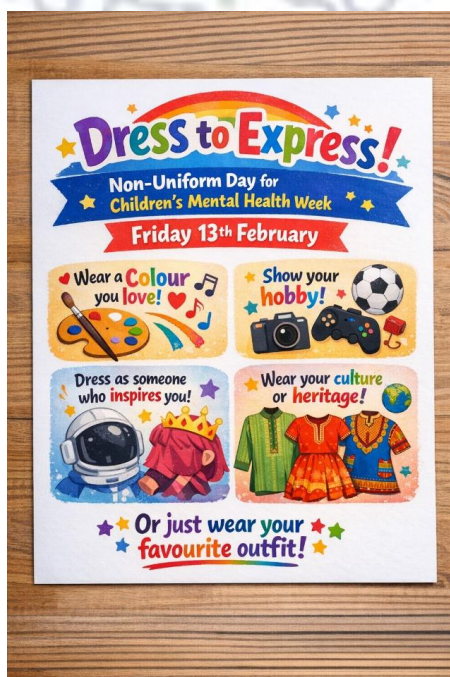
It has been lovely to welcome so many of you into school this week for breakfast. Thank you for coming along if you could – they are our favourite mornings of each half term!
