

Dear parents/carers,

A text message was sent out 02.06.26 with all the Mount Cook information needed for this week. Due to our new website going live, the information previously posted has now been removed from the website. Some parents are asking for the timings, so please find a summary of the necessary information.

- Arrive at school by 8:15am in non-school uniform. We will be starting activities fairly quickly at the centre, so something comfortable ready for some adventures! Our bus will be leaving at 9am, so we must be on time! This will give us time to go to the toilet, sort any medications and load luggage onto the coach.
- We are stopping off at Matlock Bath on the way to Mount Cook, where we will eat lunch and play in the arcades. Please send children with spending money if you wish (this is up to you how much - I would advise no more than £10) for the arcade and their packed lunch in a backpack, NOT in the main luggage. The luggage will not be accessible until we get to Mount Cook.
- On Friday, we will eat lunch at Mount Cook and then board the bus at 12:30pm. This will give us an estimated time of return of 1:15pm. I will keep parents updated via text message if traffic on the day changes this.
- You are welcome to collect children early, otherwise children will stay and relax in school until 3:30pm

**** Please note, we have had a technical glitch (just as we were printing the documents to take!) and a column of the medical data has been deleted. To ensure we have all the required information, please complete the medical form sent via text today as soon as possible - thank you so much. If you are unable to fill this in online, please find Miss Fretwell in the morning for a physical paper copy to complete.

**** Several new medications have been stated on the online medical forms compared to the paper copies - please can any medication be in a labelled bag/container ready to hand to Miss Fretwell in the morning. These have to be checked in and signed by an adult, so cannot be in main luggage.
